

MARLEIGH PRIMARY ACADEMY

Consultation on admission arrangements for the 2026-27 school year

Anglian Learning Trust, as the admission authority for Marleigh Primary Academy, is consulting on proposed changes for the September 2026 school year.

Schools are required by section 1:45 of the School Admission Code 2021 (the Code) to undertake consultation when changes are proposed to their admission arrangements. As a new school, Marleigh was opened in 2022 with interim admission arrangements which, reflecting the circumstances of a new school serving a newly established community, did not include the presence of a sibling within the criteria. As the school is now established, with classes serving the full age-range, the time has come to incorporate the standard Anglian Learning admission arrangements, which all of its primary schools use.

The consultation process allows any concerns, or comments, about these changes to be raised. **Your views are now sought on these proposals.**

The consultation period is taking place over the period starting on 25 November 2024 and closing on 20 January 2025.

At the end of the consultation period, decisions will be made based on the responses and the arrangements will be 'determined' by Trustees as required by section 1:49 of the School Admission Code 2021.

The agreed admission arrangements will be determined by 28 February 2025 and published by 15 March 2025, for the September 2026 school intake.
