News from our classrooms

Blackbirds Class

Blackbirds have been busy learning outside this week. In maths lessons the children have been learning about **capacity**. They had a variety of containers for which they had to first predict the volume and then measure with an appropriately sized measuring jug/cylinder.

They all showed a good understanding of **Litres** and **Millilitres** as their predictions were pretty accurate! They then completed challenge cards to compare different volumes and find equivalent volumes.















Spitfires Class

Spitfires have continued to enjoy our **Transport** topic this week! We've had lots of fun washing toy cars in the water tray and cleaning larger bikes and vehicles in our outdoor area. Excitement is building as we've been told about our upcoming bus trip—please keep an eye on your emails for the permission form!

We've also been learning about the importance of **handwashing** and practising how to do it properly, especially before lunch.

Our **Welly Wednesday** adventures with Mrs Wordsworth in the Forest Area have been a real highlight. The children have loved exploring nature, learning the Forest School rules, and listening carefully during our visits.

In **Maths**, we've been exploring **patterns**, creating our own designs in the provision areas. In **Phonics**, the older children have been learning the sounds 'ee' and 'igh', while the younger children have been tuning into different voice sounds and exploring alliteration, noticing how words can start with the same sound.


