CHALLENGE ONE

DT

This half term we are participating in a cooking unit about biscuits!

Try following a recipe with an adult's help at home. Create a food review about the dish that you make!

CHALLENGE TWO

Computing

Our new unit is learning about computing systems and networks.

'How Information Travels' Poster:
Draw a diagram showing how a message might travel from one computer or device, through a router, across the internet, to a friend's device and reply be sent back to you.
How do we keep safe?

CHALLENGE THREE

PE

Our new unit is Outdoor Adventurous Activities (OAA) and is about using the outside area and teamwork.

Design a short 'adventure trail' at home using safe objects (indoor or outdoor). You could draw a map or make a set of clues to guide someone through it.

You could include things like:

- cushions to step across like a river,
- chairs to crawl under like a tunnel,
- a teddy to rescue from a 'mountain',
- paper arrows or signs to follow.

CHALLENGE FOUR

Science

We are learning about how our digestive systems work in Science this half term.

The 'Stomach in a Bag' Activity:

1. **Choose a soft food:** For example: bread, banana, or crackers.
2. **Place it in a sealed plastic bag:** Add a little water or juice to represent stomach liquids.
3. **Mash and squeeze carefully:** Gently squish the bag to model how the stomach churns food.

CHALLENGE FIVE

Geography

In Geography, we are learning about different types of settlements. Imagine you are designing a new settlement. First decide whether it will be a village, town, or city.

Draw a map or diagram of your settlement. You could include:

- Homes and buildings (schools, shops, hospitals).
- Transportation (roads, train stations).
- Natural features (rivers, hills, forests).
- Write a short paragraph explaining what makes it special or unique.

CHALLENGE SIX

Maths

Times tables are so important for underpinning knowledge of the Maths curriculum.

Write a song or poem to help people remember their 3, 4, 6 or 8 times tables. You could add dance moves too!

CHALLENGE SEVEN

Our Talent Showcase

Towards the end of March, we are excited to be putting on a Years 3 – 5 performance of talents!

Practise a talent to join in the fun! You might like to sing, dance, play an instrument or demonstrate a sport skill. We can't wait to see how creative you all are!
