CHALLENGE ONE

Science - Plant Based Materials

Material Hunt

Look around your home for things made from plant-based materials, such as paper, cotton, wood or cardboard. Draw or write about 5 objects you find. Can you explain which plant material they may have come from?

CHALLENGE TWO

Geography - What Is It Like to Live by the Coast?

Coastal Postcard

Imagine you are visiting the seaside. Create a postcard to send home. You could include waves, sand, cliffs, boats, shells, seagulls or a lighthouse. Write 3 sentences about what it is like to live or visit near the coast.

CHALLENGE THREE

PE - Sending and Receiving / Striking and Fielding

Garden Games

Practise sending and receiving with a ball, beanbag or rolled-up socks. Try throwing and catching, rolling to a target, or striking with your hand or a bat. Can you make up your own mini game and explain the rules?

CHALLENGE FOUR

RE – Where Do Some People Talk to God?

Special Places

Some people talk to God in special places, such as churches, mosques, synagogues, temples or at home. Draw a special place where someone might pray, reflect or talk to God. Label what makes the place peaceful or important.

CHALLENGE FIVE

PSHE – Economic Wellbeing / Transition

My Money Choices

Imagine you have £5 to spend. Draw or write what you would buy, save or share. Can you explain why you made those choices? Think carefully about needs and wants..

CHALLENGE SIX

Transition - Moving On

My Year 2 Memory Jar

Draw a jar and fill it with your favourite memories from Year 2. You could include a lesson you enjoyed, a friend who helped you, something you are proud of, or a funny moment. Write one thing you are looking forward to next year.

CHALLENGE SEVEN

English - Baby Bear's Chair

Design a New Chair

Baby Bear needs a brand-new chair! Design and draw a chair that would be perfect for him. Add labels to describe it using expanded noun phrases, such as 'soft, cosy cushion' or 'strong wooden legs'. Can you write 3 sentences about your design?

CHALLENGE EIGHT

Music - Pitch

High and Low Sound Hunt

Find objects at home that can make sounds. Tap, shake or gently scrape them. Sort the sounds into high pitch and low pitch. Draw your objects or write a list. Can you create a short pattern using high and low sounds?

CHALLENGE NINE

Computing - Data Handling: Space Station

Space Station Survey

Ask people at home a question about space. For example: What is your favourite planet? Would you rather visit the Moon or Mars? Record your answers in a tally chart or pictogram. Can you write one sentence explaining what your data shows?
