## CHALLENGE ONE

### Science – Animal Hunt

Go on a walk or look around your home/garden and spot different animals. Can you sort them into groups?

## CHALLENGE TWO

### DT - Stable Structures Challenge

Using things from home (blocks, books, recycling, cups), build the tallest tower you can that stays standing for 10 seconds.

## CHALLENGE THREE

### Music

Create your own underwater sounds using your voice, body percussion or objects from around your home. Practise making loud, quiet, high and low sounds ready to share in class.

## CHALLENGE FOUR

### Geography – Local Area Walk

Go for a short walk and spot features in your local area (e.g. shop, park, road, church, playground). Draw a simple map or picture of one thing you saw.

## CHALLENGE FIVE

### Computing - Data Collection

Choose something to count at home (cars, socks, spoons, pets, colours, etc.). Make a simple tally chart and tell us which group had the most.

## CHALLENGE SIX

### PSHE - Jobs at Home

Talk to an adult about jobs people do at home. Can you help with one job this week? Draw or write about the job you helped with.

## CHALLENGE SEVEN

### RE - Acts of Kindness

Do one kind or caring thing for someone at home or school. Draw a picture or write a sentence about what you did and how it helped someone.

## CHALLENGE EIGHT

### PE - Throw and Catch Challenge

Practise throwing and catching with a ball, rolled-up socks or a soft toy. Can you throw underarm to a partner or into a target?

## CHALLENGE NINE

### English - Special Memories

In Grandad's Island, Syd remembers special times with Grandad. Draw or write about a special memory you have with someone important to you. What did you do together? How did it make you feel?
